## **NEW LEGISLATIVE PROVISIONS**

Effective February 21, 2003

### **Restraint Systems: Section 4581 A(1), (1.1), (2)**

**(1)** All drivers are responsible to secure children from birth to age four in an approved child passenger restraint system. The fine is waived if driver shows proof of a car seat. (primary law)

**(1.1)** All drivers are responsible to secure children four years of age or older but under eight years of age in a seat belt system and an approved child booster seat. The fine is waived if driver shows proof of a car seat. (secondary law)

**(2)** All drivers are responsible to secure all children eight years of age or older but under eighteen years of age anywhere in the vehicle in a seat belt system. (secondary law)

**Offense:** Failure to comply with the provisions in (1) or (1.1) shall be guilty of a summary offense with a maximum fine of \$100. Failure to comply with provisions in (2) shall be guilty of a summary offense with a fine of \$10.
