ORDINANCE 2012-01

**An Ordinance of the Township of West Pikeland, Chester County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
Eliminating Compensation Paid To Supervisors**

The Board of Supervisors of West Pikeland Township does hereby enact and ordain as follows:

Whereas, the Second Class Township Code, at Section 606, authorizes the Supervisors of the Township to receive compensation if the amount of such compensation is established by ordinance, and;

Whereas, by Ordinance 1998-01, adopted January 5, 1998, the Supervisors' compensation was established in the amount of \$1,875.00, to be effective January 1, 2002.

Whereas, the Board of Supervisors desires to eliminate the compensation received by the Supervisors as each Supervisor begins a new term in office so that all Supervisors beginning a new term will no longer receive compensation from the Township.

Now therefore, it is hereby enacted and ordained that:


1. The Supervisors shall not receive compensation for their service as Supervisors of the Township upon the commencement of a new term;
2. This Ordinance amends in entirety Ordinance 1998-01, adopted January 5, 1998, as the current ordinance eliminates the Supervisors' compensation formerly authorized in the amount of \$1,875.00, and;
3. If any part of this Ordinance is declared invalid, such declaration shall not affect the remainder.


This Ordinance shall take effect immediately. Enacted and ordained this 17th day of January, 2012.
