VI. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

 - i. Consider creating a fundraising group Friends of Pine Creek Park Playground.
 - ii. Considering creating a 501c3 group for fundraising
 - iii. Ryan will be the head of the Friends Group
 - 1. Start with an awareness campaign
 - iv. Joe will review with township to determine if the township has the resources to assist.
 - d. Ryan ordered two benches and will build and place when they arrive (\$900 each)

2. Disc Golf

- a. Tee pad one was installed. It is the last tee that needed to be pre-excavated.
- b. Sam reached out to Natural Lands Trust to determine if activity is permissible in the easement so we could reset two more holes higher on the hill.
- 3. Pine Creek Park Invasive Remediation Project
 - a. Not going to happen in 2024 due to financial issues and timing.
