ORDINANCE NO. 2000-4

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST PIKELAND ,
CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE EARNED
INCOME TAX ORDINANCE OF WEST PIKELAND TOWNSHIP,
ORDINANCE NO. 11-1972**

BE IT ENACTED and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the Board of Supervisors of West Pikeland Township that the West Pikeland Township Earned Income Tax Ordinance, Ordinance No. 11-1972 is amended as follows:

Section I. Section IV, entitled "Imposition of Tax" is amended to read as follows:

Section IV. Tax levied; amount. A tax for general revenue purposes in the amount of 1% is hereby imposed on earned income, including, inter alia, salaries, wages, commissions, bonuses, incentive payments, fees, tips and other compensation received by the residents of the Township of West Pikeland, and on earned income , including, inter alia, salaries, wages, commissions, bonuses, incentive payments, fees tips and other compensation received by non-residents of the Township of West Pikeland for that portion of work done or services performed or rendered in the Township of West Pikeland or the entirety of such earned income of such residents for work or services wherever performed if such work or services originate from employment with an employer having a principal place of business in West Pikeland Township, and on the net profits received from businesses, professions or other activities conducted by residents of the Township of West Pikeland and the net profits received from businesses, professions or other activities conducted in the Township of West Pikeland by non-residents of the Township of West during the period beginning on the first day of October 1972 and continuing for each taxable year thereafter.

Section-II. Severability. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such remaining

provisions, sentences, clauses sections or parts hereof. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

Section III. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days following enactment as by law provided.
