Ms. Vigilante called the meeting to order on March 18, 2024, at 7:30 PM and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Ms. Mifsud made a motion to approve the agenda of the March 18, 2024, Board of Supervisors meeting. Mr. Costa seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Mr. Hallman made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 4, 2024, Board of Supervisors meeting. Ms. Mifsud seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

REPORTS

Police: Chief Clark reported that for the month of February there were 543 calls managed, 834 hours worked, 6,840 miles were traveled, 185 traffic stops, 78 of the traffic stops resulted in citations, 107 warnings issued, two suspicious persons, two suspicious vehicles, one harassment, two suspicious conditions, and one warrant service.

Treasurer Report /Approval of Bills: Ms. Guistwhite provided her written report to the Board. There were no questions. Mr. Costa made a motion to approve the bills. Ms. Mifsud seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously apart from Mr. Hallman, as he abstained from the WEX Bank check.

Gazebo: Mr. Romano presented two grass options to the Board, sod, and seed. The Board decided on laying grass seed. Mr. Romano stated that the seed would be laid on Wednesday, March 20 at 8:30am. Ms. Vigilante and Mr. McLewee stated they will attend and provide help.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Mr. Hallman stated that former Township Manager Ed Hill has passed away. Mr. Hallman stated he was the West Pikeland Township Manager responsible for the move of the Township Offices to their current place. Mr. Hallman requested a moment of silence for Mr. Hill.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Approval of Generator Bid Package (w/ pre-bid meeting): Mr. Romano stated that the date of the pre-bid meeting is "to be determined." The Board approved the package as is.

NEW BUSINESS

Acceptance/Approval of 2024 Mowing Bid: Mr. Romano stated that the lowest bidder was DeStefano Landscaping, Inc. Mr. Hallman made a motion to accept the 2024 Mowing Bid. Ms. Mifsud seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Resolution 2024-10; Supporting the Pennsylvania Commission for the United States Semi quincennial (America250PA): Mr. Hallman asked that this effort be posted allowing community members the opportunity to participate. Mr. Romano shared this event will be overseen by the Historical Commission and posted on the Township's home page and social platforms. Mr. Hallman made a motion to approve Resolution 2024-10. Mr. Costa seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

ANNOUNCEMENTS


The next Board of Supervisors meetings are scheduled for Monday, April 1, 2024, and Monday, April 15, 2024, at 7:30 PM.
