### Executive Summary:

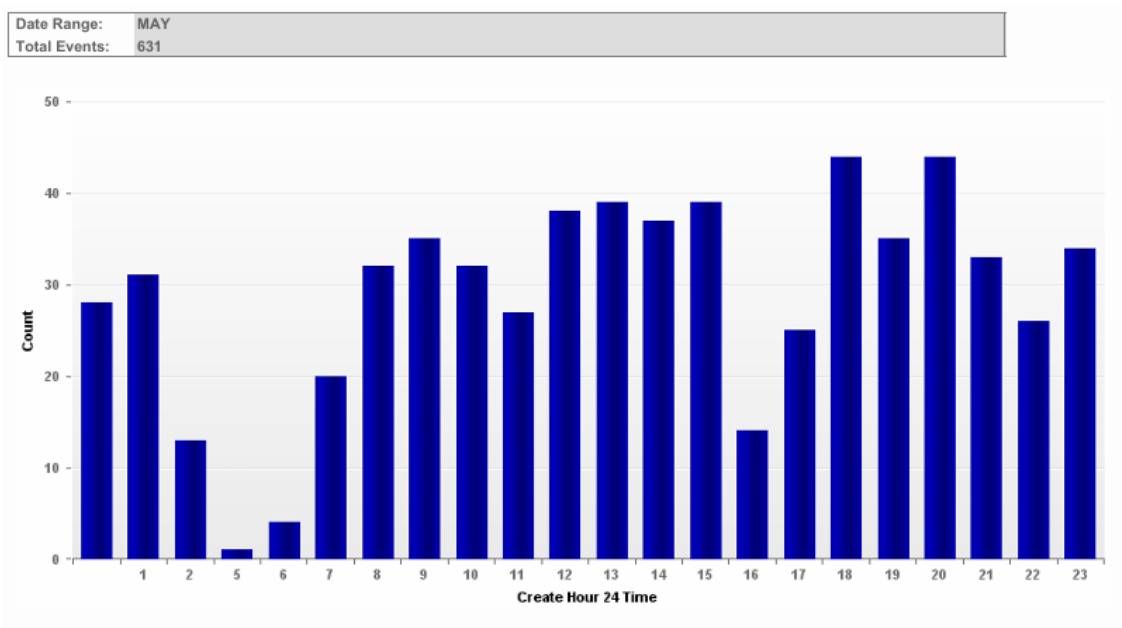

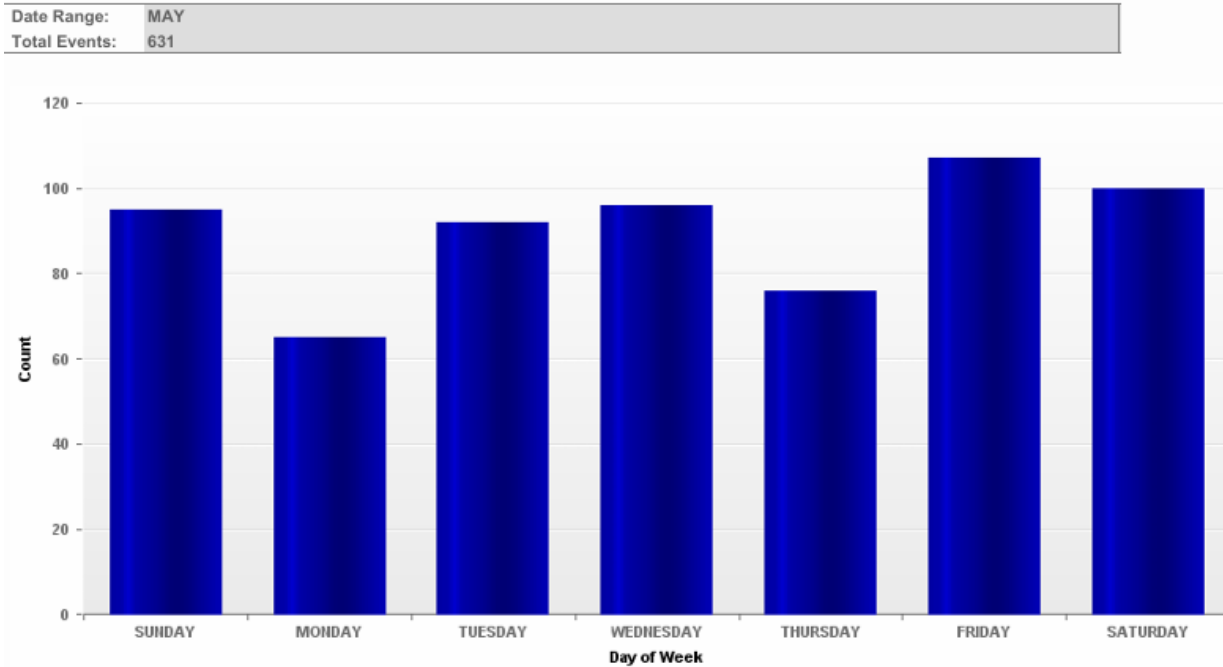
