RESOLUTION NO. 2025-13 DESTRUCTION OF MUNICIPAL POLICE RECORDS

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WEST PIKELAND TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, DECLARING ITS INTENT TO FOLLOW THE SCHEDULES AND PROCEDURES FOR DISPOSITION OF RECORDS AS SET FORTH IN THE MUNICIPAL RECORDS MANUAL APPROVED ON DECEMBER 16, 2008 (AMENDED MARCH 28, 2019).

WHEREAS, by virtue of Resolution No.2025-13, adopted August 18, 2025, West Pikeland Township declared its intent to follow the schedules and procedures for the disposition of records as set forth in the Municipal Records Manual approved December 16, 2008, and,

WHEREAS, In accordance with the records retention and disposition requirements outlined in 46 PA Code § 15.59, and ensuring full compliance with the CJIS Security Policy for secure handling and destruction of criminal justice information, the following records stored at the Township Building have met or exceeded their legally mandated retention periods and are scheduled for secure destruction: All materials have been reviewed and determined to have no ongoing administrative, legal, or historical value.
