Ms. Vigilante called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Ms. Mifsud made a motion to approve the September 2, 2025, Board of Supervisors agenda. The motion was seconded by Mr. Costa and passed unanimously.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Ms. Mifsud made a motion to approve the minutes of the August 18, 2025, Board of Supervisors meeting. The motion was seconded by Mr. Costa and passed unanimously.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Ms. Vigilante reported that an executive session was held on August 26, 2025, and another was scheduled for September 2, 2025. The topic of discussion for both sessions was personnel.

PROCLAMATION

Exceptional Public Service--Officer Robert McCarron.

Mr. Hallman made a motion to approve Proclamation 2025-03, acknowledging and honoring Officer McCarron for his many years of service to West Pikeland Township. The motion was seconded by Ms. Mifsud and passed unanimously.

The proclamation was read by Officer DeForrest. Following the reading, Sergeant O'Connell, Officer in Charge, presented a bouquet of flowers to Mrs. McCarron in tribute to her many years of support for Officer McCarron. Sergeant O'Connell then delivered remarks about working with Officer McCarron before presenting him with his police officer retirement badge and credentials. Officer (Ret) McCarron spoke of his time with the department especially the interaction with the township's residents. He acknowledged the role his wife played in his role as a police officer, and thanked leadership, fellow officers and the residents for the opportunity to serve.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

General Code (eCode 360) Update

Mr. Romano updated the Board on the General Code project, which has now entered the Editorial and Legal Analysis phase—an in-depth, chapter-by-chapter review of the Township’s legislation. The project team includes the Township solicitor, engineer, building codes officer,

and members of the Planning Commission. The team will review 139 questions, providing an opportunity to make necessary revisions. All stakeholders are involved at this stage, and the completed review will be returned to General Code no later than December 8, 2025.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Ms. Vigilante opened the floor for public comment.

- -Non-Resident Shane Clark expressed his belief that the next Police Chief and Sergeant are already present in the room and encouraged the Board to look no further.

- -Resident Jill Walsh shared that recent personal incidents have been more tolerable knowing the West Pikeland Police Department is on duty. She especially acknowledged and appreciated Officer McCarron's years of service.

-Supervisor, Mr. Hallman, asked Mr. Romano when Mr. Simpson would return to share the report's findings. Mr. Romano stated Mr. Simpson was not scheduled back. Mr. Hallman asked Mr. Romano to contact Mr. Simpson and ask him to return to present the report's findings.
