Executive Summary:

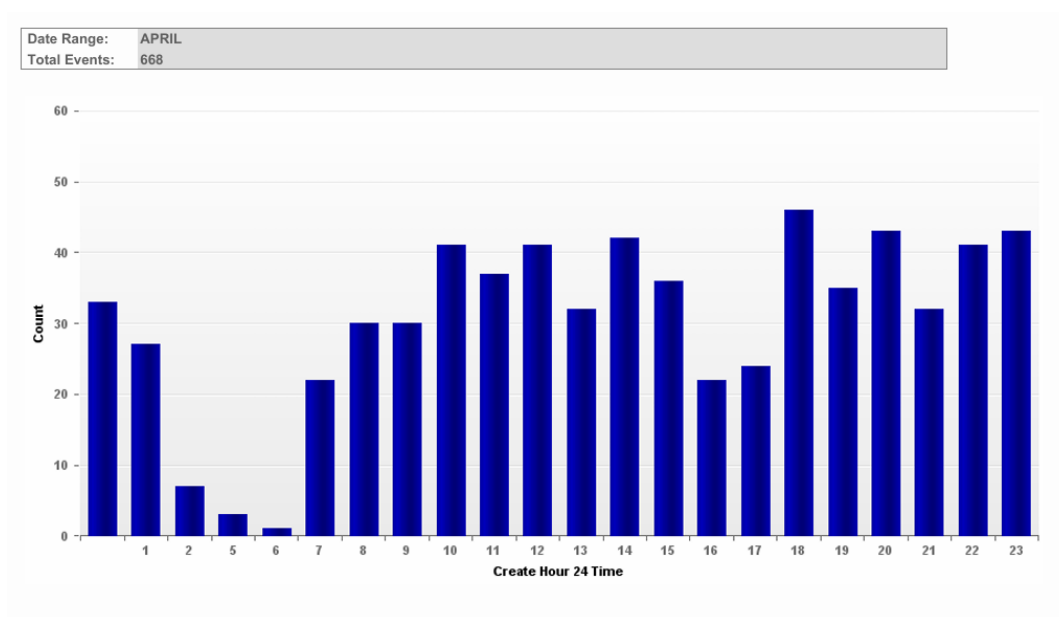

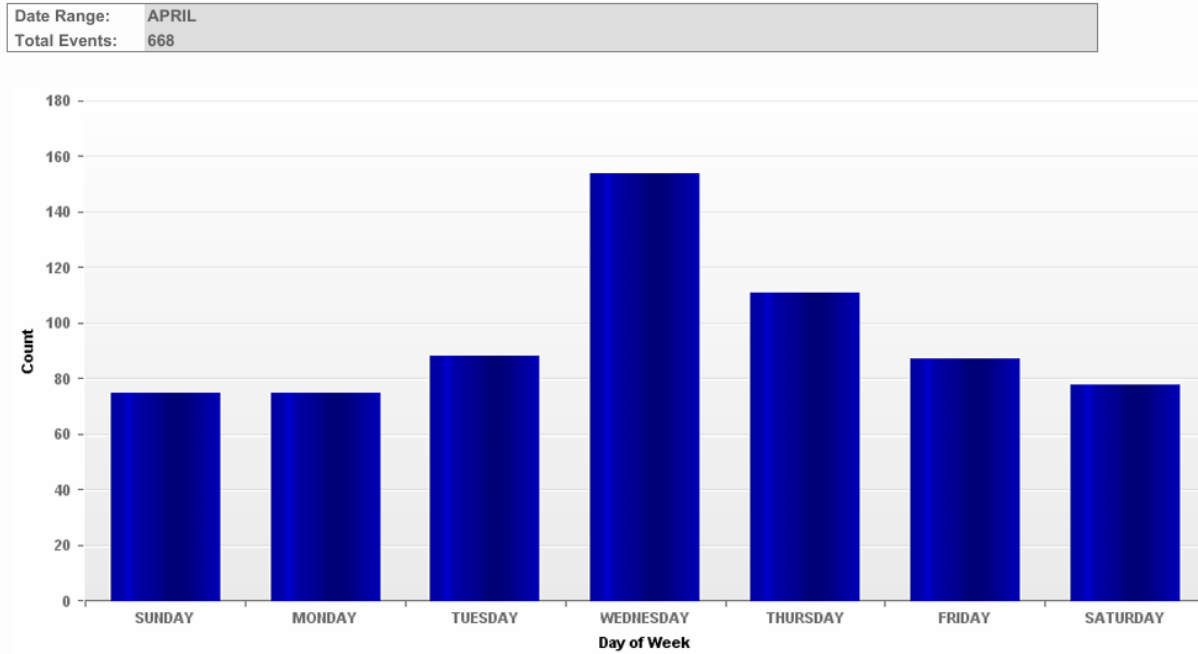
