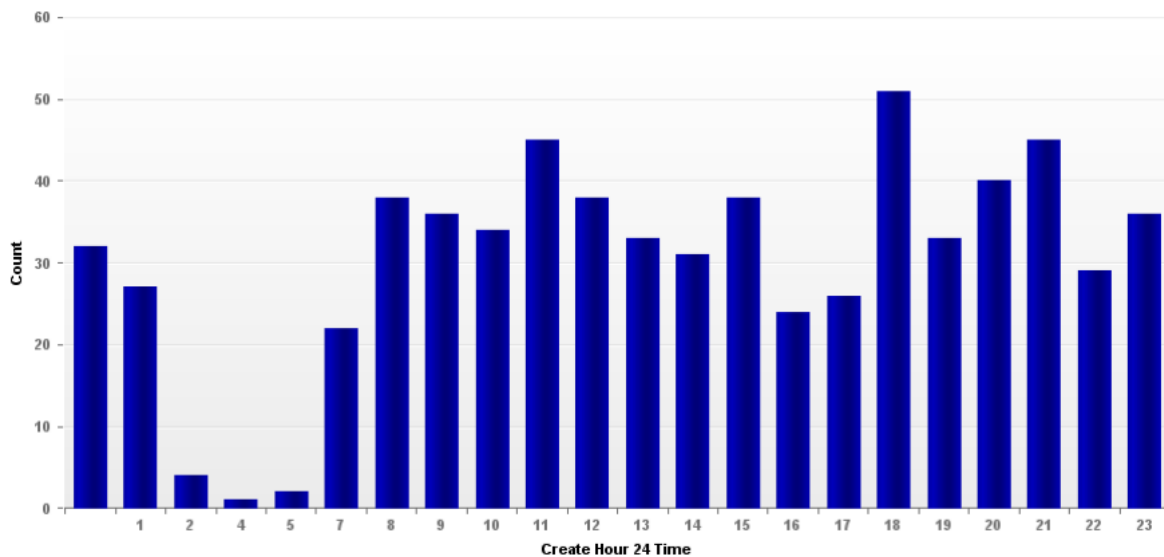

*Dispatch Incident Counts include vacation and business property checks, etc., that do not require entry into the Cody Record Management System. This is a normal data variation.

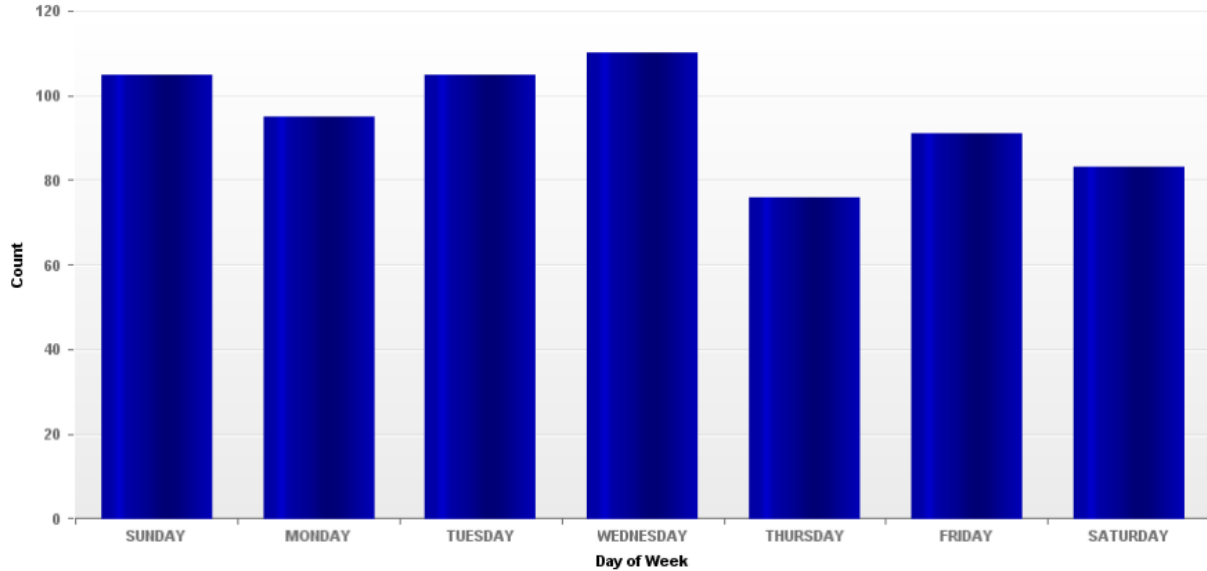
Activity by the Hour:
